The Pups rule:

Steps:

1. Apostrophe looks like a mini nametag...and a mini nametag means someone owns something or has possession.

Conclusion: Mini name tag= possession

Mr. Spups ate a pup's cup
The 3 pups ate a super pups' cup

2. If you see a mini nametag...put your index finger over it.

Practice: with your finger over the mini nametag now lift your finger up and say: "with possession"

Note: No mini nametag...no possession There are 3 pups over there.

- 3. With finger on mini nametag, now look to the left.
 - a. Is it singular or plural? Shreeya's nametag
 We have two girls in Junior Genius named Shreeya.
 The Shreeyas' nametags are blue.
- 4. Now look to the right:

Is there possession or not? The Shreeyas' nametags are blue.
There are pups over there.

- a. Possession or not?
- b. Is the thing to the right singular or plural?
- c. Does the answer you are checking make sense?

Simplified review of steps:

- 1. Cover mini nametag
- 3. Look right:
 - a. possession or not
 - b. singular or plural
